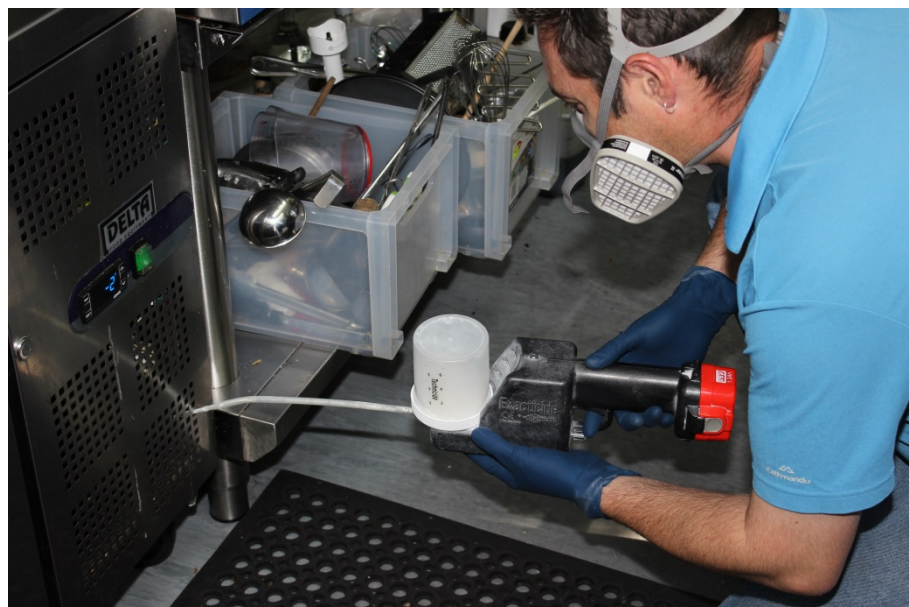


New Zealand Certificate in Pest Operations (Level 3) Urban Pest Control



Programme overview

This programme aims to provide the Urban Pest Management (UPM) industry with competent technicians who have the skills and knowledge required to safely carry out pest management in built environments with limited supervision.

This programme is designed to recognise the skills and knowledge of individuals who are already working in the UPM industry, including those who have recently become employed.

This programme leads to the New Zealand Certificate in Pest Operations (Level 3) with a strand in Urban Pest Control.

Graduates will be able to:

- Maintain health and safety in a range of conditions.
- Communicate, report and record information for workplace requirements.
- Identify the purpose and impacts of pest control activities.
- Identify, control and monitor pests commonly found in an urban environment.

How long will it take?

Fees:

\$200 qualification fee payable to Careerforce on enrolment. \$3000 (GST inclusive) covers all coursework/materials and the practical on-site assessment and is payable to Pacific International (payment plan available).

Graduates of this qualification may progress their skills and knowledge by training towards the New Zealand Certificate in Pest Management (Level 4).

This qualification replaces the National Certificate in Urban Pest Management (Level 2) with optional strands in Fumigation, Vertebrate Pests, Wood Borer, Shooting, Bird Control, Textile Pests, Bedbug Control, and Ant Control.

Do you already have the National Certificate?

If you already have the National Certificate in Urban Pest Management (Level 2), you only need to complete 2 unit standards to achieve the New Zealand Certificate in Pest Operations (Level 3) Urban Pest Control.

Complete the standalone unit standards application form and pay the following fees:

- \$155 (GST inclusive) qualification fee payable to Careerforce and
- \$300 per unit standard (+GST) to Pacific International for all coursework and assessment.

Graduates of the National Certificate in Urban Pest Management (Level 2) only need to complete the following unit standards:

- 28786** Demonstrate knowledge of the purpose and impacts of urban pest management (3 credits)
- 28787** Demonstrate knowledge of the legislative framework and regulatory controls governing the urban pest management industry (3 credits)
